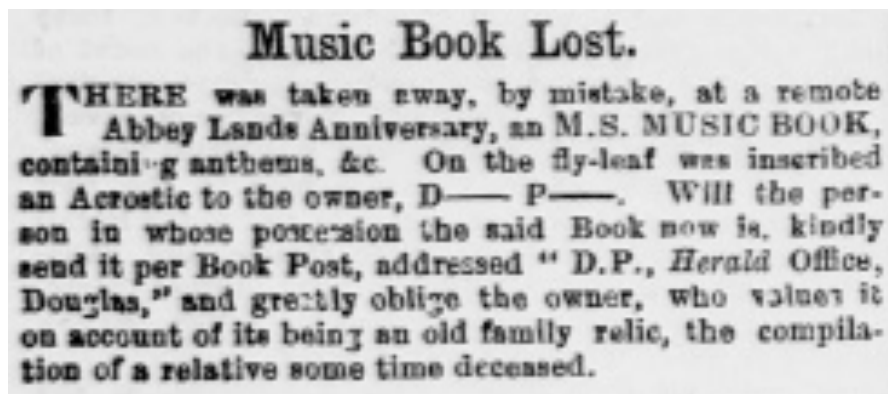


## “MUSIC BOOK LOST”
