P.W. CAINE (1887–1956) *



P.W. Caine was a folk song collector and a member of Sophia Morrison’s circle though his collection is now lost.¹ Here is a photograph of Caine, evidently taken later on in life, but it at least allows us to put a face to the name; its poor quality is due to it being sourced from newsprint, namely his obituary in the *Ramsey Courier*.²
